


√ Keeps iPods locked & secure

TEACHERS

- √ Calendar for keeping track of conferences, IEPS, staff meetings, etc.
- √ Note taking in a meeting, or documenting student misbehavior
- √ Contact list to store parent contact information & email addresses
- $\sqrt{\text{Safety procedures (tornado drill, fire drill, etc.)}}$ and class list with you always
- √ Check weather before going out for recess

STUDENTS

- √ Allows for movement around the classroom
- √ Answer poll questions in class
- √ Experience with technology tools found in the real world
- √ Can travel to music, P.E., and other special classes
